Commercial Automobile Classification Guidelines

Sheriff Department Vehicles

1. PC – those vehicles equipped with emergency equipment (lights, sirens, etc.)
2. Other vehicles – classify according to General Classifications.

Fire Department Vehicles

1. FT – those vehicles used for fire fighting purposes, or equipped with emergency equipment (lights, sirens, etc.)
2. Other vehicles – classify according to General Classifications

General Classifications

1. PU – vehicles of the pick-up type.
2. LT - Trucks (not dump trucks) with manufacturer published gross vehicle weight of 10,000 pounds or less.
3. MT – Trucks (not dump trucks) with manufacturer published gross vehicle weight of 10,001 pounds to 20,000 pounds.
4. HT - Trucks (not dump trucks) with manufacturer published gross vehicle weight of 20,001 pounds to 45,000 pounds.
5. XHT - Trucks (not dump trucks) with manufacturer published gross vehicle weight over 45,000 pounds.
6. TT – Truck-tractor (vehicle with a fifth wheel coupling device for semi-trailers) with published manufacturer gross vehicle weight of 45,000 pounds or less.
7. XHTT – Truck-tractor (vehicle with a fifth wheel coupling device for semi-trailers) with published manufacturer gross vehicle weight greater than 45,000 pounds.
8. MD – Dump truck with a manufacturer gross vehicle weight of 20,000 pounds or less.
9. HD – Dump truck with a manufacturer gross vehicle weight of 20,001 to 45,000 pounds.
10. XHD – Dump truck with a manufacturer gross vehicle weight of more than 45,000 pounds.
11. TR – any trailer or semi-trailer.
12. AMB – any vehicle used to carry patients or used as an emergency responding vehicle.
13. BUS – any vehicle used to carry passengers.
14. VAN – any vehicle of the cargo van type that is not a PC, FT, AMB or BUS.
15. PPT – any vehicle of the private passenger type that is not a PC, FT, AMB or BUS.
