



## Defensive Driving Training

KCAMP recommends defensive driving training for all personnel who drive member vehicles as part of their duties; however, the course is open to all member officials, employees, and volunteers. In addition to benefiting the member by encouraging improved driving behavior, participants become eligible for discounts on their personal auto insurance. Also, completion of defensive driving training at least every three years is a criterion of KCAMP's Risk Management Achievement Award, which reimburses a percentage of a member's annual contribution for implementing important risk management practices.

**Course:** National Safety Council Defensive Driving Course

**Format:** Live classroom training

**Trainer:** Lauren Lewis or Patrick Smith

**Time:** 2 hours per class

**Cost:** NO COST for member personnel

Non-member individuals (e.g., employees of other municipalities or family of member personnel) may attend a member-organized training for \$7 per person, to cover the cost of materials. The KCAMP member is responsible for collecting payment from non-member trainees.

**Requirements:** A classroom setting is preferred, but not required. If your facility will not accommodate large groups, we can schedule multiple classes.

Audio-visual equipment is also preferred (the course is presented via digital media). **Please discuss your facility's audio-visual capabilities when scheduling training.**

Please email your typed attendee list in the Excel format provided, which will facilitate issuing the course certificates. Attendees will be asked to initial the list on the day of training.

**Materials:** Each participant is provided with a course guide.

Everyone should bring a pen or pencil.

**Certificates:** A certificate of completion will be issued to each participant. The certificates will be mailed after the training to the person organizing the event on behalf of the KCAMP member.
